

**Meeting on Sunday not to oust Dr Wan Azizah, says PKR MP**

**KUALA LUMPUR,** The meeting called by PKR this Sunday was to give further clarification to party members about the formation of Pakatan Harapan (PH).

Kuala Langat MP Abdullah Sani Abdul Hamid said all members have been informed about the meeting and that it was not something big enough to undermine the position of the party.

He said there were issues about the new coalition and the need for clarification.

“Its a special meeting and I do not know of any petition.

“This has nothing to do with the dissatisfaction of PH, but the members need further clarification regarding the party’s standing to enable them to mobilise the grassroots.

“The meeting is to explain their positions and seats within PH and nothing further,” he said when contacted by The Rakyat Post.

On a “petition” that was being heavily rumored, Abdullah said “logically there were 72 committee members but only 25 had signed it, so its no big deal”.

Political analyst Prof Dr Shaharuddin Badaruddin said the meeting would not be discussing the position of anyone in the party.

He referred to the statement of PKR member Badrul Hisham Shahrin, or better known as Chegubard, that mentioned a faction belonging to PKR vice-president Mohamed Azmin Ali that intends him to take over from party president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail.

“This has nothing to do with the president. This is just a discussion on internal party issues and is a very normal process,” he told *The Rakyat Post*.

He said what was needed was a discussion using normal procedures so that party members were informed about the discussion.

He also denied there were members that objected to the PH formation last Sept 22.

“There was never an issue of agreeing or not. What is important is that the coalition must be inclusive to include everyone.

“Everyone including PAS. This is to ensure that there are only one-against-one fights between PH and Barisan Nasional.

PKR will meet this Sunday in what is rumored to be an attempt to oust Dr Wan Azizah from her post as president.

Twenty-five PKR central leadership council members have signed the petition for the meeting.
