

**Supreme Council backs Najib**

KUALA LUMPUR, The Umno Supreme Council today expressed its full support for its president, Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

It also called on all senior Umno leaders to stand together and face challenges as well as help strengthen the party and Barisan Nasional.

Speaking to reporters after the more than four-hour meeting, the Prime Minister said members had agreed to work together and present ideas to tackle current issues.

“We also discussed the Tabung Haji issue. We want to assure all depositors that their money is safe.

“All deposits in Tabung Haji are guaranteed by the government. There is no need for anyone to worry about their money.”

Najib also revealed that the 1Malaysia Development Board issue was discussed.

He said it was agreed that the Auditor-General should hasten his probe into 1MDB.

Najib said the council hoped that the Auditor-General would make a statement soon as to how the probe could be completed.

He warned that action would be taken against anyone who was involved in any kind of wrongdoing at 1MDB.

He added that the 1MDB issue had to be sorted out because the public also wanted to know the outcome of the Auditor-General’s probe.

Najib said several Supreme Council members had come forward to offer their experience and expertise to help solve the 1MDB issue.

He went on to warn those trying to drive a wedge within the top Umno leadership to put an end to it as it was not going to work.

“I met with my deputy, Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, this morning and we had a heart-to-heart discussion on all sorts of issues.

“This kind of discussions will continue so that as top party leaders we know what needs to be done.”

He added that anyone expecting any kind of surprise announcement after the Supreme Council meeting would be bitterly disappointed.

He said he and his deputy had agreed to work together to solve any problems that cropped up.
