

'If Nik Aziz is alive Kit Siang's anti-hudud ceramah in Kelantan wouldn't have happened'

KUALA LUMPUR, PAS central committee member Nik Mohamad Abduh Nik Abdul Aziz said a few PAS leaders had turned their backs on the party stand by allowing DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang to speak against hudud during a ceramah in Padang Perdana, Kelantan, on Sunday.

In a Facebook posting, Nik Abduh said if his father, the late Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat, was still alive, no PAS leaders would have dared bring to bring the DAP leader to Kota Baru to speak on rejecting hudud.

Nik Abdul Aziz was the former spiritual lead for PAS, an Islam-based party, until he passed away on Feb 12.

"Since PAS lost the late TGNA (Nik Abdul Aziz), PAS changed so fast it was as if there were some who were impatient for his death.

"With TGNA around, no PAS leaders would dare to bring and accompany LKS (Lim) to Kota Baru to speak on rejecting the law of God (hudud)," wrote Nik Abduh.

Nik Abduh also advised all PAS members to strengthen their resolve in continuing on with their efforts with PAS president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang.

Last Sunday, DAP used Jordan and Egypt as examples to continue rejecting the implementation of Syariah Criminal Code Act II in Kelantan, which PAS hoped to table in Parliament in the near future.

As DAP adviser, Lim said that although the populations of both countries were over 90% Muslim, they had yet to implement Islamic law.

The ceramah, which was organized by PAS Kota Baru, was also attended by PAS deputy president Mohamad Sabu and PKR vice-president Rafizi Ramli.
