

Ibrahim Ali expected Pakatan Rakyat to break up

KUALA LUMPUR, The Pakatan Rakyat (PR) crisis that is happening was expected by Malay right-wing group Perkasa.

Its president, Datuk Ibrahim Ali, said the difference in ideologies of PAS and DAP was one reason for the conflict.

He opined that PR would not have been able to guarantee a stable nation because of the differences between the two parties and now that had become a reality.

DAP, he said, had its own intentions when it was with PAS in the coalition and, likewise, PAS.

“Why didn’t Perkasa support PR before this? Firstly, because of (Datuk Seri) Anwar Ibrahim who was found guilty and imprisoned and, secondly, because of DAP.

“To us, DAP just entertained PAS to gain Malay votes and PAS used DAP to gain support of the Chinese,” he told The Rakyat Post.

He further explained that the crisis that engulfed PAS and DAP proved that the two parties could establish sharing of power, but that would not enable PR to last long.

“PAS and DAP have no concrete goals of networking.

“Now that this has happened, Perkasa’s and my personal stand have shown to be accurate and true.

“Meanwhile, PKR, Anwar’s personal party, will also not last long.

“PR’s politics is only to blame others, not see the elephant in the room,” he added.
