

PAS sec-gen denies party's plan to sack critical members

KUALA LUMPUR, May 25, — PAS secretary-general Datuk Mustafa Ali denied today reports that the Islamist party plans to sack three of its members for criticising party leaders.

According to the party's mouthpiece *Harakah Daily*, he dismissed the media reports as fabrications made up before the PAS muktamar next month.

"In PAS, we don't have a problem, you can give your opinions," Mustafa told *Harakah Daily*.

"Giving your views honestly and in a constructive way is normal in PAS. In PAS, giving a good suggestion to the party is not a sin. There is no reason to take action over that. I want to remind everyone not to make incorrect and inaccurate statements about PAS," he added.

Local daily *Sinar Harian* reported today that Former Royal Malaysian Air Force (RMAF) major Zaidi Ahmad was due to be sacked together with PAS Youth committee member Sulaiman Ibrahim and PAS Muslimat central committee member Wan Aishah Wan Ariffin for criticising PAS leaders.

Zaidi has also denied the report.
