

Najib Visits Kuching Waterfront, Famous Sarawak 'Kek Lapis' Venue

KUCHING, Feb 26 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak this evening headed to the Kuching Waterfront here to begin his walkabout as part of his three-day visit to Sarawak.

Accompanied by Sarawak Deputy Chief Minister Tan Sri Alfred Jabu, Sarawak Tourism Minister Datuk Amar Abang Abdul Rahman Zohari Tun Openg and other Sarawak ministers, he took a 'perahu penambang' (boat) to cross the Sarawak River to visit Kampung Gersik, which is famous for its Sarawak 'kek lapis' (layered cake) entrepreneurs at 6 pm.

The prime minister then made a stopover at one of the well-known kek lapis shops here, "Mira Cake House" and sampled several cakes on offer.

He and his entourage then visited a row of food eateries at Medan Selera in Kampung Boyan to meet the people and traders there.

Najib spent about 30 minutes during the walkabout here and later enjoyed a noodle dish of 'Kolak Mee,' that is synonymous with Sarawak before heading back to the jetty.

He did not dashed the hopes of the people present when he took 'selfies' with several patrons who had patiently waited for his arrival to catch a glimpse of the nation's number one leader since 5 pm.

The prime minister who arrived here this evening is also scheduled to officiate the Urban Transformation Centre (UTC) here tonight.
