

**Najib Vows To Continue Helping Sarawak Prosper**

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 28 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said he promised to step up efforts to bring prosperity to Sarawak and improve the living standards of people in the state, particularly those residing in rural areas.

In the latest posting on his Facebook page Saturday the prime minister, who had visited Medan Niaga Satok in Kuching this morning, said he also promised to maintain the existing unity in the state and objected to elements of extremism that were in conflict with the 1Malaysia concept.

He also had the opportunity to interact with traders and the public during his visit there.

"The traders and the public have given some feedback to me on a few things like the cost of living and infrastructure in Sarawak. This is what I want - communication between leaders and the people," he said.

Najib who was a three-day working visit to Sarawak from Thursday launched the Urban Transformation Centre in Kuching, laid the foundation of the Sri Aman Hospital in Sri Aman, launched the construction of the Beladin Community Hall in Betong and opened the Serian Water Treatment Plant.

He also officiated the Chinese New Year gathering in Kuching during the visit.
