

Action Plan For Child Protection In Cyber World To Be Implemented Soon - Rohani Bernama

KUALA LUMPUR, March 3 (Bernama) -- The Action Plan for Child Protection in the Cyber World will be implemented as soon as possible to face potential cyber threats to children in the country.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Rohani Abdul Karim said the plan had already received the Cabinet's approval on Feb 11.

"The plan proposes protection measures which emphasize on advocacy action, prevention and intervention, as well as support service," she said when opening the Charity and Welfare Body of Wives of Ministers and Deputy Ministers' (Bakti) 38th Annual General Meeting (AGM) at Bangunan Bakti Siti Hasmah, here, Tuesday.

The meeting was attended by Bakti president Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, who is also the prime minister's wife, and deputy president Puan Sri Norainee Abdul Rahman, who is the wife of deputy prime minister.

Rohani said the plan could become a guideline for parents and guardians to protect children from falling victims to cyber threats, such as the invitation for youth and children to join the so-called IS militant group through Facebook as reported by the media recently.

She said the plan would also be discussed at the Regional Conference On Child Online Protection to be organised by the ministry on March 24 to 25.
