

MIC Negeri Sembilan Leaders Urge Palanivel To Resolve Party Confusion

SEREMBAN, Jan 17 (Bernama) -- Five of the eight MIC divisional chiefs in Negeri Sembilan have urged party president Datuk Seri G. Palanivel and his deputy Datuk Seri Dr S Subramaniam to hold immediate discussions on resolving the confusion in MIC.

Rembau MIC chief Datuk V.S. Mogan who is also an MIC Supreme Council member said it was crucial for the party to resolve the issue promptly as party members had been in limbo over it.

"We do not know what is happening in the party with regards to the communication between the party president and Registrar of Societies (ROS).

"On Dec 18, the president said he would look into the issue with his deputy and form a committee to study ROS' order and resolve it," he told reporters here today.

On Dec 5, ROS ordered MIC to hold a re election for its three vice presidents' posts and 23 central working committee slots within 90 days.

The ROS made the order following findings of power abuse and misconduct in violation of the party's constitution and Societies Act.

Also present at the press conference were the divisional chiefs for Jempol, Datuk L. Manikam; Kuala Pilah, M. Kalidas; Jelebu, P. Supramaniam; and Teluk Kemang deputy chief, P. Letchumanan.
