

Muhyiddin Receives Report On 2014 UPSR Examination Leak

PUTRAJAYA, Jan 21 (Bernama) - Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today received a report on the 2014 Ujian Pencapaian Sekolah Rendah (UPSR examination) leak from the Independent Committee To Review Public Examinations in Malaysia.

The report submitted by independent committee chairman Tun Zaki Azmi includes 15 recommendations to improve public examinations, involving the definition and work processes at production, operation and management level.

It also contains an analysis and evaluation of work processes and standard operating procedures of public examinations managed by the Malaysian Examinations Board.

The report said the independent committee met 22 times and obtained input from briefings, interviews, working visits and the public.

The independent committee was formed following the leak of Science and English Language papers for the 2014 UPSR examination causing the candidates to resit for the papers.
