SHAH ALAM, Jan 22 (Bernama) -- The PAS-led Kelantan state government appreciated all the cooperation and assistance provided by the Federal government in helping the state deal with the massive floods recently.

Kelantan Deputy Menteri Besar Datuk Mohd Amar Nik Abdullah said the spirit of cooperation between the two governments was at its best than ever before.
