

**PM's Willingness To Visit Father Very Meaningful For Our Family - Nik Mohamad Abduh

KOTA BAHARU, Jan 31 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's willingness to visit PAS spiritual leader Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat currently receiving treatment at the intensive care unit (ICU) of Hospital Universiti Sains Malaysia (HUSM) last Thursday was very meaningful for his family.

The former Kelantan Menteri Besar's son, Nik Mohamad Abduh said even though the visit from the country's top leader was only for a while, the gesture was very much appreciated by the whole family.

"Thank you Prime Minister for visiting my father (Nik Abdul Aziz). Although the visit was brief and father was tired, it was meaningful for me and our family. Thank you Malaysians," he said in his latest entry in his Facebook account, Saturday.

Last Thursday, the prime minister during his one-day visit to the state spent about 10 minutes to see for himself the progress of Nik Abdul Aziz's health, accompanied by Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Ahmad Yakob and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.

Nik Mohamad Abduh said his father was recuperating well and showed positive development at present.

"Alhamdulillah, despite still fatigue, father can undergo rehabilitation well, improving from day to day," he said.

"While undergoing physiotherapy treatment yesterday, father can already stand up on his own for about 30 minutes," he added.

Nik Abdul Aziz, 84, was admitted to HUSM last Jan 19 after his health deteriorated during the recent floods besides suffering from prostate cancer.

The Chempaka state assemblyman is also Kelantan's fifth menteri besar from 1990 until 2013.
