

**MH370 deliberately flown towards Antarctica, according to TV documentary**

As the first year anniversary of Malaysia Airlines flight MH370's mysterious disappearance approaches, a National Geographic documentary suggests the plane was deliberately flown off-course towards Antarctica.

UK daily The Mirror reported aviation experts quoted in the television documentary as saying that flight MH370 made three turns after its last contact with air traffic controllers.

The first turn was to the left and two more turns took MH370 west, then south towards Antarctica, according to the documentary which airs in UK on March 8, the first anniversary of its disappearance over the South China Sea.

Flight MH370 vanished on March 8, 2014, shortly after departing Kuala Lumpur with 239 people on board for Beijing.

Almost a year later, not a single piece of the missing Boeing 777 has been found.

Malcolm Brenner, an expert in the causes of aviation disasters, was quoted as saying the turns "strongly suggest" someone in the cockpit deliberately flew MH370 off-course.

"This accident has caught the attention of the world in a way I have not seen in a 40-year career in aviation," Brenner was quoted as saying by the UK newspaper.

On January 29, Malaysia declared flight MH370 lost in an accident that had killed all 239 passengers and crew members on board.

The initial search and rescue operations covered the South China Sea, Strait of Malacca, Andaman Sea and southern Indian Ocean, involving 65 aircraft and 95 vessels and experts from 25 countries.

The search and rescue phase transitioned to an underwater search and recovery phase led by the Joint Agency Coordination Centre and the Australian Transport Safety Bureau (ATSB).

The current search for the Malaysia Airlines plane is set to end in May and the ATSB commissioner Martin Dolan said he was hopeful his team would unearth the wreckage by then. – February 24, 2015.
