

**Government Committed To Build Affordable Homes For Rakyat - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, March 12 (Bernama) -- Prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said the government is committed to the agenda of building affordable homes for the rakyat.

He said that under the program 'Perumahan Rakyat 1Malaysia' (PR1MA), the aspiration of more Malaysians to purchase their own home would become a reality.

"Alhamdulillah (Praise be to Allah). The government is committed to the agenda of building affordable homes and Insya-Allah (God willing), through PR1MA Homes the dream of more Malaysians to purchase their own homes will become a reality," he said in his latest entry in his Facebook account, here today.

In his entry, Najib also shared a video lasting 3.15 minutes from his 1Malaysia Facebook account telling the story of Norazam Azman's family who were among the earliest buyers of the PR1MA homes.

It told of how the less-affordable group such as Norazam, 33, who has a wife and two children, had to stay in his in-law's home and rented a low-cost house before being able to finally own a home through the PR1MA program.

Last Saturday, the prime minister handed over the keys to a section of the 560 owners of PR1MA homes at the first site of the project at Precinct 11, Putrajaya.

PR1MA units were offered to Malaysians with an average monthly household income of between RM2,500 and RM10,000 to own high-quality homes at strategic locations costing between RM100,000 and RM400,000.
