

**Malaysia, Myanmar Waive Visa Requirement For Government Officials, Business Travellers -

KUALA LUMPUR, March 13 (Bernama) -- Malaysia and Myanmar have agreed in principle to waive the visa requirement for government officials and business travellers, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"In the Malaysia-Myanmar delegation meeting earlier today, we agreed in principle to waive the visa requirement for government officials and business travellers," he said in his latest tweet on his Twitter account, tonight.

Earlier, Malaysia's Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman said the move was to ease the travelling for these groups between the two countries.

With the agreement, government officials and business people who are endorsed by their respective chambers of commerce from both countries would not require visa.

Najib and visiting Myanmar President U Thein Sein held talks today to discuss developments in bilateral cooperation.

Thein Sein, who was accompanied by wife, Daw Khin Khin Win, arrived here Thursday on a two-day maiden state visit to Malaysia.
