

Najib Confident KUIN-YPPM MoU Benefits Private Religious School System

KUALA LUMPUR, March 14 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is confident the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Kolej Universiti Insaniah (KUIN) and Yayasan Pembangunan Pondok Malaysia (YPPM) will bring development to the private Islamic religious school system.

"Through this MoU, a Religious School Study Centre (PKP) will be set up in KUIN.

"I am confident it will bring progress to the private Islamic religious school system and play an important role in future, insya-Allah (god willing)," he said in his latest Twitter and Facebook postings Saturday.

According to him, the oldest education system in the country was the Islamic religious school system.

Under the 2015 Budget, the government announced an allocation of RM25 million for the religious school system so that it continued to progress in the modern development, said Najib.

The Prime Minister today opened the KUIN PKP which functioned as a research and development centre on Islamic religious schools and its system in Nusantara apart from witnessing the MoU signing ceremony.

Under the MoU, KUIN will provide expertise and manpower needed for the programme which will be conducted jointly with YPPM as well as research facilities such as the library, hall and other supporting logistics.

YPPM will provide the expertise and manpower as well as other physical assistance such as logistics and networking.
