

**Vehicle Registration Plate Offences: More Than RM800,00 In Fines Collected From Nov To Jan**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 18 (Bernama) -- From Nov 1, 2014 till Jan 31, RM810,300, was collected in fines for vehicle registration plate offences, said Transport Minister Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai.

He said 12,161 summonses were issued by the Road Transport Department (JPJ) on this during that period.

"Guidelines and specifications on vehicle registration plates are clearly spelt out under road transport regulations," he said in a written reply to Teresa Kok Suh Sim (DAP-Seputeh) in the Dewan Rakyat today.

He said the specifications must also be heeded for any new vehicle models to be registered in Malaysia and details could be accessed at [www.jpj.gov.my](http://www.jpj.gov.my).

On other matters, Liow said till last February, RM958.24 million from the Public Transport Trust Fund (KWAPA) had been spent for various projects, among them to improve the public transport system in Sabah and Pahang and supporting stage bus operators.

The balance in the fund now stood at RM152.82 million, Liow said in a written reply to Liew Chin Tong (DAP-Kluang) who wanted to know the expenditure incurred since the fund was set up 10 years and with fuel subsidies removed.
