

**Water Level In Seven Selangor Dams Above Critical - MB
Bernama

SHAH ALAM, March 5 (Bernama) - The water level in seven Selangor dams is above critical level and adequate to meet the needs of users in the state.

Selangor Menteri Besar Mohamed Azmin Ali said the water supply in the state is under control.

"Tasik Subang Dam recorded the highest water level at 97.51 per cent followed by Semenyih Dam at 94.7 per cent," he said in a statement, here Thursday.

Azmin said the five other dams are Sungai Langat (94.64%), Batu (89.07%), Klang Gates (86.79%), Sungai Selangor (75.05%) and Sungai Tinggi (69.62%).

"This level is higher than over the corresponding period last year. For example on March 4, 2014, Sungai Selangor Dam recorded 44.84 per cent compared to today's reading of 75.05 per cent.

"We also found that water consumption per capita for users in Selangor is at a high of 235 litres daily. Users should reduce water usage to ensure continuous supply," he added.
