

Use Suitable Approach To Criticise Najib - Pahang Mubarak

KUANTAN, April 10 (Bernama) -- The Pahang branch of the Malaysian Council of Former Elected Representatives (Mubarak) feels that anyone can criticise the leadership of prime minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to bring about improvements but the approach used must be appropriate.

Its president, Datuk Dr Abdul Halim Mansor felt that former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad should use a different approach to criticise Najib, instead of doing it openly as this could lead to an unpleasant situation.

"Criticism can be made with the intention of making an improvement. But it should be in a fatherly manner, where it (criticism) will not be made in the open which will result in the 'mistake' becoming a topic of discussion," he said.

He disclosed this to Bernama when asked to comment on the open criticism made by Dr Mahathir against Najib recently.

Abdul Halim also felt that Najib should not necessarily give a 'verbal reply' to the questions raised by Dr Mahathir because 'action is more believable than words'.

However, he said, the prime minister as the person being questioned should be given time to prove his action was in the interest of the people and country.
