

Mobile Van Team To Enlighten Public On GST

PUTRAJAYA, April 20 (Bernama) -- The Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism Ministry (KPDNKK) set up a mobile van team to go around enlightening the public on the implementation of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) starting this week.

KPDNKK secretary-general, Datuk Seri Alias Ahmad said the team will also provide advice regarding GST, in addition to taking immediate action on the reports and complaints made by the public.

"The vans will be at hot spots such as markets and supermarkets so that explanations can be made to the general public more easily," he said in a press conference with the Customs Department GST Division director Datuk T.Subromaniam, here today.

Meanwhile, Subromaniam advised people not to continue believing any false information in the social media on GST, which came into force on April 1, without prior investigation and urged them to contact the Customs authorities and the ministry to get the actual information.
