

## **Muhyiddin Arrives In Jakarta For Three-day Working Visit To Indonesia**

JAKARTA, April 7 (Bernama) -- Malaysian Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin arrived here Tuesday for a three-day working visit to Indonesia.

The special aircraft carrying Muhyiddin landed at the Halim Perdanakusuma International Airport at 5 pm (6 pm in Malaysia).

He has a tight schedule during the visit. This evening, he is scheduled to have a dinner with 400 Malaysians at the Grand Hyatt Jakarta Hotel.

On Wednesday morning, Muhyiddin, who is also education minister, will meet Indonesia's Education and Culture Minister Anies Rasyid Baswedan and Research, Technology and Higher Education Minister Muhammad Nasir.

He is also scheduled to make a courtesy call on Indonesian President Joko Widodo before meeting Vice President Jusuf Kalla and having lunch with him.

In the evening, he is scheduled to meet Malaysian businessmen.

On Thursday, Muhyiddin is scheduled to deliver a keynote address at the Malaysia-Indonesia Clerics and Preachers Forum, which carries the theme 'Malaysia-Indonesia Unity in Tackling Extremism'.

It is expected to be attended by 60 clerics and preachers from the two countries.

Two papers will be presented at the forum, by Malaysia's Federal Territories Mufti Datuk Dr Zulkifli Muhammad Al-Bakri and Chairman of the Indonesian Ulama Council (MUI) Prof Dr Din Syamsuddin.

In the evening of the last day of his visit, Muhyiddin is scheduled to meet with Indonesian media editors-in-chief before returning to Kuala Lumpur.
