

Najib Continues To Receive Support From Government Leaders

KUALA LUMPUR, April 8 (Bernama) -- Various parties have continued to express unwavering support for the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak to continue leading the country.

Gerakan expressed solid support for Najib and called on all parties to give full support to the Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman, seen as the best person to lead the country, said party president Datuk Mah Siew Keong.

He said Malaysians must also be confident in Najib's leadership to ensure the country continued to remain in the mainstream of development to become a developed nation and achieve Vision 2020.

"I am confident of the prime minister's leadership because he has brought much transformation which has been positive for our country. He has worked relentlessly to develop the country even though he was facing a political landscape which had changed a lot in the past 10 years," he said in a statement here today.

The Indian Progressive Front (IPF) has expressed full confidence and support for Najib's leadership as he had always defended the welfare of the Indian community and society as a whole.

IPF president Datuk M. Sambanthan said all party members fully supported the prime minister who was seen leading the political, economic and social transformation of the country.
