

**No GST On Items Sold In 1Amanjaya Mobile Shop - Zambry

IPOH, April 8 (Bernama) -- The 1Amanjaya Mobile Shop (KB1AJ) does not impose the Goods and Services Tax (GST) on items sold in its premises, according to Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir.

Not only that, he said the KB1AJ was even offering a five per cent discount on all of the items.

"This is our approach to help and alleviate the burden of the people and the low-income earners in the rural areas," he told reporters after launching the new KB1AJ lorry here today.

KB1AJ, managed by Yayasan Bina Upaya (YBU), had begun operation in April last year and had recorded 45,860 customers with sales of RM1.5 million so far.

"Maybe one day, if we have the ability, we will set up our own business outlet like the 1Malaysia People's Shop in each constituency," he said.

Zambry said the state government would continue increasing the number of KB1AJ lorries so that the mobile shop could reach to the customers' areas quickly.

"With the increased number of lorries, we hope the mobile shop will be able to make a complete round of the customers' areas within two to three weeks compared to a month previously," he said.

Among the items sold in the KB1AJ mobile shop were rice, cooking oil, flour, powdered milk, onion, dried chili and herbs.
