

## **Call For Supermarkets To Put On Display List Of GST-exempted Goods**

HULU TERENGGANU, April 5 (Bernama) -- All supermarkets should put on display the list of goods that are not subjected to Goods and Services Tax (GST) to help consumers make choices.

The call was made by Deputy Communication and Multimedia Minister Datuk Jailani Johari, who also said that the list should be displayed at the entrance of the supermarkets to alert the consumers.

"At the same time, Domestic Trade, Cooperatives and Consumerism Ministry (KPDNKK) Offices in all states should help produce leaflets containing list of goods exempted from GST to be distributed to supermarkets for display.

"If the list is displayed at the entrance, it will be easier for consumers to clearly see the list of goods and make better choices," Jailani, who is also the Member of Parliament for Hulu Terengganu, told reporters after a price-monitoring visit to a supermarket in Kuala Berang Sunday.

Also present was Senior Assistant Director of Terengganu KPDNKK Anti-Profiteering Unit Saidi Ismail.

Meanwhile, Saidi said over 500 premises in the state were inspected since the first day of the GST implementation.

As at yesterday, he said 18 notices under section 21 of the Price Control and Anti-Profiteering Act 2011 were issued to traders who were believed to have committed profiteering offences.

"We have also received over 100 complaints and enquiries from consumers since the first day of GST implementation," he added.
