

**Investigation On Helicopter Crash Will Start Immediately - Liow
Bernama
April 5, 2015**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 5 (Bernama) -- Transport Minister Datuk Seri Liow Tiong Lai said investigations into the helicopter crash at Semenyih which killed six people, would start immediately with priority to locate the helicopter's voice recorder.

He said an investigation committee had been formed to investigate the incident.

"They (committee) will go to the crash site to gather the wreckage to determine the cause of the accident. The most important part is the voice recorder because it can assist our investigation," he said while met at the Kuala Lumpur Hospital Forensic Unit here, today.

Liow said a post-mortem was being carried out on all bodies.

He said, in order to speed up the identification process of the bodies, three Disaster Victim Identification (DVI) teams have been formed.

"Before confirming the identify of the deceased, we need to carry a number of process and procedures, like finger print, dental structure and DNA. That is why we have formed three DVI teams to expedite the process," he said.

Meanwhile, the Department of Civil Aviation Director-General Datuk Azharuddin Abdul Rahman said investigations would start immediately.
