

**MCMC Always Cooperates With PDRM To Block Spreading Of IS Militant Videos - Jailani

HULU TERENGGANU, April 5 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) has always cooperated with the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM) to curb the spread of videos by the so-called IS militant group (IS) that became viral on social media websites and applications, said Deputy Communication and Multimedia Minister Datuk Jailani Johari.

"Usually when there are IS related videos and other videos that should not be disseminated are being spread, MCMC will take appropriate action if there is a request from the police to block any website and this matter is not new.

"MCMC has always cooperated with the police in terms of monitoring sites that are not suitable and we have a special committee comprising the police and MCMC, as well as several other agencies," he told reporters after presenting book vouchers and consolation prizes to 350 outstanding students in Hulu Terengganu Sunday.

Yesterday, Home Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi asked MCMC to block videos on IS cruelty that were spread in social media.

Jailani, who is also Hulu Terengganu Member of Parliament, said the ministry was aware of the existence of several websites related to IS.
