

BN backbenchers say no move to replace Najib, just talk

The BN Backbenchers Club (BNBBC) has again come out in defence of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, saying there is no movement within Umno to replace him, Sinar Harian reported today.

Chairman Tan Sri Shahrir Abdul Samad said talk of a move to replace Najib with his deputy Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin was mere speculation.

"I have not heard about this. This is all created by those who want to see the peace disrupted.

"To me, there is no group who wants to see Datuk Seri Najib Razak go down, while Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin is elevated," he said, according to the report today.

Shahrir was commenting on talk that Umno grassroots had decided to ask its highest leadership to vacate all positions in the party and government.

"This is Malaysia, many stories are created. And we cannot stop this story and that," he said in the report, adding that BNBBC was satisfied with the leadership of Najib and Muhyiddin.

In the report, Shahrir praised the government's open policy under Najib, who he said had not only strengthened the institution of Parliament, but also further established the role of MPs, especially from Barisan Nasional. – April 13, 2015.
