

Hadi, Tuan Ibrahim leading PAS nominations

Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang and Datuk Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man received the most nominations for the post of PAS presidency and deputy presidency over the weekend, leaving their contenders in the dust ahead of the PAS general assembly in June.

Out of the 16 PAS divisions which met during the weekend, 15 nominated Hadi for the presidency while just one nominated Datuk Husam Musa.

All 16 also chose Tuan Ibrahim for the deputy presidency, putting him far ahead of incumbent party No. 2 Mohamad Sabu, popularly known as Mat Sabu.

Hadi now has 60 nominations for the PAS presidency, Husam has eight, Ahmad Awang has three and Tuan Ibrahim one nomination.

Tuan Ibrahim received 59 nominations for the post of deputy president, while Mat Sabu is defending his position with just nine nominations.

Four leaders from the ulama's (scholars') faction also won the most nominations for the vice-presidency: Bukit Gantang MP Idris Ahmad, Temerloh MP Nasrudin Hassan, Kelantan deputy menteri besar Datuk Mohd Amar Nik Abdullah, and Selangor executive councillor Datuk Iskandar Samad.

The trend of the nominations so far indicates that the scholars have the upper hand over the rival professionals faction.

Yesterday, former Selangor PAS commissioner Dr Rani Othman also lost his post as Kapar PAS chief to his former deputy, Najhan Mohd Salleh. – April 20, 2015.
