

Sex blogger Alvin at it again, this time with video on Azan

Controversial sex blogger Alvin Tan has once again earned the wrath of Malaysians, after posting a video of him singing a cover of the Azan, or the Islamic call to prayer, on his Facebook page earlier today.

The post has since garnered some 3,270 shares and hundreds of comments from angry Muslims and non-Muslims, who have criticised him for mocking the sacred call that rings out at mosques five times a day, signalling the time of prayer.

The video, which is slightly less than three minutes long, saw Tan shirtless but donning sunglasses and playing his keyboard to the Azan.

"And please don't badger me about the wrong lyrics... First, this is a cover, so creative modification is permitted. Second, I ain't a suicide bomber, aight," he said in the posting.

"My latest goal is to get all mosques in Malaysia to play my cover, instead of having them old geezers hunched over the mics, straining their vocal chords and cracking their voices. Let them geezers rest already... preferably in eternal peace."

Facebook user Matthew Ryan Lee said: "This is stupid... u insulted the muslims...for what?? What's the purpose of doing all these kinda thing? Please dont bring up more issues about race than it already has now..and ur voice is annoying as ****."

"Basic human rights... Freedom of speech.. You can exercise that all you want Alvin Tan..nobody is stopping you..

"But try to use some emotional intelligence and respect when you do so..Dats how you use freedom of speech, with wisdom. If not, you r just being what you R good at.. Being an attention seeker," said Sri Sapine.

"I guess he thinks he can do anything n say anything he wants or like... Well the day will come Alvin... Judgement day will always be nearby for ppl like you, who think religion is a joke or something for u laugh at. Anyways I hope u enjoy urself while u can," added Joo Hun.

Dqie Rokawa Danny said: "This gone too far dude. Im not a Muslim but you shouldn't do this. Even im still mad because some ppl protest to take down the cross few days ago..but im still try to be tolerate"

Besides the criticisms, several Muslims appeared to praise Tan for his attempt at singing the Azan, noting that it showed he seemed open to the religion.

"Almost there but not complete. Good effort but need to polish the nounces to be right & correct. I'm muslim & i'm not angry. One day you will be one of of us brother.

Believe Allah's will. Allahu akbar!," said Wan Usj.

Anuar Helmee Haqq said: "Welcome to islam Alvin TanI proud of you, on the hardwork to understand islam....one day you will be my brother ..hopefully..."

"Alvin Tan . Without u notice you already recite the syahadah. You know what syahadah means? Its the word that you will recite to convert into Islam. Thank God, keep learning bout Islam. May God open ur heart one day and accept islam," added Naim Afandi.

Tan is currently in Los Angeles, California, after fleeing the country seven months ago in a bid to seek political asylum in the United States.

Tan, 26, and his former partner, Vivian Lee, 25, are facing criminal charges under Malaysia's Sedition Act 1948 as well as the Film Censorship Act for their controversial online uploads, including a photograph on Facebook deemed insulting to Islam.

Last December, the Immigration Department revoked his Malaysian passport, with its director-general Datuk Mustafa Ibrahim saying that such individuals would not be "tolerated". – April 21, 2015.
