TAWAU, May 10 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak does not only has the backing of Sabah UMNO, he can also count on the support other Barisan Nasional (BN) components in the state.

Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman said state BN leaders conveyed their undivided support for the country's top leader to him during a recent meeting.

Other state leaders include State Assembly Speaker Datuk Seri Salleh Tun Said Keruak, Urban Wellbeing, Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Abdul Rahman Dahlan, Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman and Defence Deputy Minister Datuk Abdul Rahim Bakri.
