

**High Performance School Continue To Show Positive Results - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, April 28 (Bernama) -- The High Performance School (HPS) programme, which is among the initiatives under the Government Transformation Programme (GTP), is showing positive results in cultivating a high-performance culture.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said this in his speech at the launch of the 2014 GTP and Economic Transformation Programme (ETP) Report in Kuala Lumpur, Tuesday night.

He said, 13 more schools were identified as HPS, bringing the total to 128 schools.

"Hopefully, HPS will continue to produce students who are competent and outstanding in all aspects," he said.

The initiative to improve the quality of education was under the Education National Key Result Areas (EDU NKRA).

Under the same initiative, over RM100 million were provided as fee assistance to almost 130,000 pre-school students in private institutions and those among low-income households.

School fees amounting to almost RM7.5 million were also given to more than 3,000 children placed in private child care centres.
