

Resolve Dr M-Najib spat amicably, not debate, says MCA

The recent spat between former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak should be solved in a more "amicable" way instead of a debate, MCA secretary-general Datuk Seri Ong Ka Chuan said today.

Speaking to reporters at the sidelines of an interfaith prayer session for the Nepal earthquake, Ong said a better solution must be found to settle the Dr Mahathir-Najib feud.

"Debates tend to be not very amicable."

Dr Mahathir in a forum yesterday said that he was prepared to debate Najib, after intensifying his criticism on Najib's leadership over the past few months.

Dr Mahathir had called for the prime minister's resignation but the latter remained insistent on staying put.

Ong also warned that the spat will not only affect BN's image, but also the government's image as a whole.

"Differences in opinion must be managed well.

"This is affecting our common interests."

He also said that Putrajaya having constant criticism will not bode well in the international community.

"Its not only confidence from locals, but the confidence of the international community will be affected too." – May 17, 2015.
