

**Najib Visits Senior Citizens And Handicapped In Pekan

PEKAN, June 13 (Bernama) -- "I couldn't talk. I was speechless because I was so happy when PM (Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Najib Tun Abdul Razak) hugged me," said a senior citizen on his feelings when meeting the prime minister here, Saturday.

Mohamad Nor Ali, 85, said he never dreamed his two-room house where he lived with his wife Timoh La-Nga, 55, in Kampung Bukit Udang, here would be visited by 'very important people'.

"I cried the moment he greeted me. I was so overwhelmed that I could only hug him back (when he hugged me)," he told Bernama here, today.

Mohamad Nor, who has four children with Timoh, aged between 18 to 27, also said Najib was happy when he saw they were using the refrigerator and television set given by the government after the floods in 2013.

Meanwhile, Timoh said Najib was smaller than her impression of him on television.

Najib took the opportunity to visit Mohamad Nor's house as he had a programme to distribute Ramadan contributions at the Kampung Bukit Udang surau, about 50 km from Pekan.

Earlier, Najib, who is Pekan Member of Parliament, visited and handed over his personal contributions to the family of handicapped, Ayu Maskon, 47, at Rumah Bersepadu, Kampung Salong here.

Ayu, supported three children, namely, Siti Nuraqilah Mohd Yunos, 14, Nur Zulaiqa, 10, and Mohd Khairul Haiqal, 6, on a government monthly aid of RM700 after her husband Mohd Yunus Abd Mamat, 55, died of heart ailment in 2010.

In addition, Ayu is also looking after her step-sister Nuraiyah Zamri, 17.

Ayu said she was so happy at Najib's visit, that she could only cry when Najib entered her house.
