

Another PAS Councillor Quits Post From DAP-Led Penang Government

GEORGE TOWN, June 17 (Bernama) -- Another PAS councillor has resigned from his position in the DAP-led Penang government following the recent spat between PAS and DAP.

Dahalan Fazil's resignation as a Seberang Prai Municipal (MPSP) councillor was effective yesterday said state local government exco Chow Kon Yeow who confirmed that he had received Dahalan's resignation that was delivered by hand to his office in Komtar yesterday afternoon, in a statement today.

He was a member of the licensing and enforcement, traffic and infrastructure, planning, building and beautification standing committee member since his appointment on Jan 7, 2015.

Yesterday, PAS member Mohd Nasir Yahya, 62, gave up his post in the Penang Island City Council (MBPP).

On Jun 6, former PAS deputy president and former Penang PAS Commissioner Mohamad Sabu had resigned from the Penang Water Corporation and Penang International Halal Hub board of directors.

Penang deputy PAS commissioner Datuk Dr Mujahid Yusof Rawa as quit his post as member of the Penang Islamic Foundation and Penang International Kolej Islam Teknologi board.

The services of Penang PAS secretary Mohd Fadzil Kemi who had served as the Information Officer in the DAP-led Penang government was ended last Friday.

Two other PAS representatives, Yaacob Omar and Omar Hassan, have yet announce their decisions.
