

Chinese Entrepreneurs Thank Najib For Allocating RM50 Million For Business Loans

PUTRAJAYA, June 17 (Bernama) -- A group of Malaysian Chinese entrepreneurs today extended their appreciation to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak for his generosity of allocating RM50 million as loans for Chinese entrepreneurs to expand their business.

President of the China Malaysia Commerce Exchange Society (Malaysia), Dr Philip Loh also conveyed the group's appreciation for the positive commerce exchange with China and facilitating many business transactions and joint venture projects between China and Malaysia's entrepreneurs.
