

Do Not Leak Classified Info Call To Civil Servants

PUTRAJAYA, June 17 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today urged civil servants to abide by the civil service pledge not to leak government classified information.

The leak of classified information before an official announcement could have dire implications on government decisions, he said at the 14th Premier Civil Service Dialogue here.

"A day or two ago, there was a leak. Please safeguard government classified information. Any government has classified information.

"If we not yet ready to make an announcement, one must not leak any information because the decision could be something else.

"Before we have decided on the toll rate, there has been talk of a raise. In fact, we have a certain methodology. Civil servants who are under oath should not take it lightly because it is for the good of the country," he said.

Last week, Najib expressed disappointment over the leak of information on a possible toll rate increase that was circulated on the social media after a report on a portal that had quoted a cabinet source.

He said the discussion on the matter by the cabinet did not come to any final decision.
