

China-Malaysia Friendship Garden Symbol Of Strong Bilateral Ties

PUTRAJAYA, June 2 (Bernama) -- Federal Territories Minister Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor on Tuesday opened the China-Malaysia Friendship Garden, another symbol of the Beijing-Kuala Lumpur diplomatic relations established 41 years ago.

"May this garden stand out to be an enduring and beautiful symbol of friendship and partnership between Malaysia and China for years to come," he said at the event.

Dongguan Municipal Government deputy mayor Yang Xiao Tang and China's Ambassador to Malaysia Dr Huang Hui Kang were present at the function.

The 0.24-hectare garden stands on the permanent grounds of the annual Royal Floria Putrajaya Flower and Garden Festival in Precinct 4 here, making it the first permanent component of the festival.

The garden, built at a cost of RM1.5 million, is in the style of the Lingnan Garden that emphasises the elements of mountain, water, stone, building, calligraphy and plants.
