

**Police Bring Down Nine More Body Bags Believed To Contain Human Remains**

WANG KELIAN, May 28 (Bernama) -- Nine more body bags, believed to contain the remains of victims of human trafficking, were brought down from the Bukit Wang Burma forest, near the Malaysia-Thailand border, today.

The police forensic team descended from the hill with the body bags at about 8.40pm.

The remains were removed from graves near an abandoned transit camp which held victims of a human trafficking syndicate.

All the bags were then put into a police truck and were taken to an unknown destination.

Members of the media had been waiting since 4pm today at the foothill for the remains to be brought out.

Yesterday, federal police issued a statement that two bodies were brought out from the transit camp.

Last Monday, Inspector-General of Police, Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar announced the discovery of 139 graves at 28 human trafficking transit camps located between Kampung Wai and Tangga 100 Felcra in Perlis.
