

**No Suspicious Activity Detected At Malaysia-Thailand Border In Kelantan**

KOTA BAHARU, June 5 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Armed Forces (ATM) has not detected any suspicious activity, such as illegal settlements at the Malaysia-Thailand border in Kelantan, especially at the heavily-forested area in Jeli.

Eighth Brigade Commander Brig-Gen Datuk Azmy Yahya said there was no illegal settlement used as transit camps to house illegal immigrants found, thus far.

"We will take action and report it to the relevant authorities if we detect any suspicious activity at the border," he told reporters after handing out flood relief assistance to the children of ATM personnel at Desa Pahlawan Camp here today.

Azmy said the public need not be worried because the situation at the border was under control.

"We will keep patrolling daily and we also have some permanent posts at the border," he added.

The nation was stunned by news of the discovery of 139 graves at 28 Rohingya refugee transit camps believed to have been abandoned by a human trafficking syndicate at the Malaysia-Thailand border in Wang Kelian, Perlis.
