

Malaysian Government Extends Condolences To Quake Victim's Families

KUALA LUMPUR, June 6 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian government has extended its profound sympathy and deepest condolences to the families of Sabah's quake victims, including foreign nationals.

The Foreign Ministry in a statement Saturday said it was saddened by the loss of lives and injuries suffered in the recent earthquake that hit Ranau and other places in Sabah, yesterday.

It said the relevant authorities were taking the necessary steps to provide immediate rescue and recovery efforts to the affected people.

The 5.9 magnitude earthquake which hit Ranau at 7.15am yesterday, with the tremors felt in several areas including Tambunan, Pedalaman, Tuaran, Kota Kinabalu and Kota Belud, has claimed 13 lives so far.

Following the incident, the ministry had also opened a 24-hour Operations Room, which is reachable at +603-8887 4570 and +603-8889 2746.
