

Letter on Selangor elections fake, says PKR

A letter purportedly announcing the Selangor government's plans to hold fresh elections after the fasting month is fake, say PKR secretary-general Rafizi Ramli.

A photo of the letter dated June 16 and bearing his signature and the PKR logo said the party's political bureau had decided on fresh polls following the collapse of Pakatan Rakyat after two of its members, PAS and DAP, ended ties with each other.

But Rafizi today tweeted that the letter was fake and blamed it on Umno's "boys" who were "bored".

"Surat ini yg kononnya dikeluarkan oleo says adalah PALSU. Perkara bias yg budak2 Umno buat bila bosan," he said (This letter purportedly issued by me is false. Normal stuff that Umno's boys do when they are bored).

Speculation over snap elections in Selangor came about following the end of Pakatan, and pressure by voices in DAP and PAS for the state's Selangor Menteri Besar Mohamad Azmin Ali to "choose" to work with either party only.

But Rafizi said although Pakatan ceased to exist as a formal pact, the state governments in Selangor, led by PKR, and in Penang under DAP, would operate as coalition governments. – June 18, 2015.
