

**Kundasang region suffers water disruption after 5.9-magnitude quake**

The 5.9-magnitude earthquake that struck Sabah on Friday morning has damaged the water drainage system in the Ranau district resulting in several places experiencing low water pressure and disruption of water supply.

Sabah State Water Department Divisional Engineer for Ranau, Anthony Jullah confirmed the situation stating that all areas in Kundasang and Ranau were experiencing water disruption.

He estimated the damage to underground drainage pipes and water tanks as reaching more than RM500,000.

"The main water drainage pipe in Kundasang had burst, several plants in both regions are also damaged and there is leakage in the deposition tank.

"From yesterday, we started repairing the damages so I expect maybe by today water supply will be restored to the Kundasang and Ranau areas."

According to Anthony, due to damages to the underground water drainage pipes, more than 20,000 consumers have been affected. – Bernama, June 7, 2015.
