

**BN Penampang Lodge Police Report On Leakage Of Information About 1MDB**

KOTA KINABALU, July 13 (Bernama) -- Penampang Barisan Nasional (BN) today lodged a police report urging an investigation and action against those who leaked confidential information about investigation on 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB).

Its chief Datuk Donald Peter Mojuntin said the current investigation on 1MDB would be adversely affected and impact negatively on the Special Task Force which is conducting the investigation.

"The investigation will be delayed again if the investigation is marred by leakage of information. Such leakages can affect security. Leakage important information can be used by interested parties and foreign nations to threaten national security, politically, economically and socially.

"This is our main concern. The integrity of the investigation must be maintained and prompt action taken on leakage of information," he told reporters at the Penampang District Police Headquarters here today.

Donald said on July 8, Attorney-General Tan Sri Abdul Ghani Patail had issued a statement on his worry on leakage of documents related to the criminal investigation being conducted.

In the statement, the anxiety of the matter was also backed by members of the task force comprising Bank Negara Malaysia governor Tan Sri Zeti Akhtar Aziz, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar and Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission chief Tan Sri Abu Kassim Mohamed.

In the meantime, Donald said those responsible for the leakage and dissemination of the confidential information on a person's bank account and account transaction clearly flouted Section 97 (1) and 97 (3) of the Banking and Financial Institution Act 1989 (BAFIA).
