

**Johor UMNO Hope PM Will Be Given Chance To Explain WSJ Allegations – Khaled Bernama**  
**July 6, 2015**

JOHOR BAHRU, July 6 (Bernama) -- UMNO Johor today hoped Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak would be given an opportunity to clarify allegations made by the Wall Street Journal (WSJ) against him.

Johor UMNO Liaison Committee chairman Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin said the Prime Minister should focus on clearing his name and Mohamed Khaled was confident the issues could resolved soon.

"The people have to listen to the explanation rather than accepting WSJ's allegations wholly," he told reporters at a breaking of fast organised by the Johor Entrepreneur Development Centre here tonight.

The Johor Menteri Besar said the Prime Minister should take whatever action rebuff WSJ's allegations which specifically mentioned his name.

The report alleged investigators found almost US\$700 million (RM2.6 billion) deposited into accounts belonging to the Prime Minister.

Deputy Prime Minister, Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin later called for legal action to be taken against WSJ to clear the good name of the Prime minister and country.
