

**1MDB Issue: Don't Jump To Conclusions, Let Authorities Complete Investigations - Khairy

KUALA LUMPUR, July 8 (Bernama) -- Let the authorities complete their investigations on the 1MDB issue and not jump to conclusions, said UMNO Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin.

He also reminded all quarters not to make confusing statements on the matter and let the authorities do their job.

"As the investigations are still in the early stages, it is too early to make conclusions. So it's better for us to wait for the outcome of the investigations which I believe will be referred to the Cabinet.

"Only after that can the next course of action be taken," said Khairy, who is also Youth and Sports Minister.

He was speaking to reporters after opening the National Sports Council's RM2.3 million Al-Faizin surau here today.

On Friday, the Wall Street Journal published a report claiming that about US\$700 million (RM2.6 billion) from 1MDB fund was channeled into Najib's personal bank accounts.

Following the allegation, a task force consisting of Attorney-General Tan Sri Abdul Gani Patail, Bank Negara Malaysia Governor Tan Sri Zeti Akhtar Aziz, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar and Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Chief Commissioner Tan Sri Abu Kassim Mohamed was formed to probe the matter.

Today, Najib was reported to have instructed his lawyers at the legal firm of Messrs Hafarizam Wan & Aisha Mubarak to send a letter to The Wall Street Journal seeking confirmation of its position on the allegations against him in its articles before taking legal action.
