

**Najib Attends Tahlil, Yasin Reading For Late Jamaluddin Jarjis**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 9 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today attended a 'tahlil' and reading of the Yasin at the National Mosque, here, for the late Tan Sri Dr Jamaluddin Jarjis, who died in a helicopter crash in April, this year.

The recitations which started at 6.30pm with about 500 attendees, were led by the chief imam of the mosque, Tan Sri Syaikh Ismail Muhammad.

Among those present were Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Abdul Wahid Omar and Rompin MP Datuk Hasan Arifin.

Earlier, Najib fulfilled his obligation of paying zakat (tithe) at the National Mosque zakat counter. The zakat payment was handed to amil (zakat collector) Mohd Rusdi Abd Salim from the Federal Territory Islamic Religious Council.

The late Jamaluddin, who was PR1MA Corporation chairman, principal private secretary to the prime minister Datuk Azlin Alias and four others were killed when the helicopter they were in crashed at Kampung Sungai Pening, Semenyih on last April 4.

The helicopter was on its way to Kuala Lumpur from Pekan, Pahang.

The other victims in the crash were the helicopter pilot Captain Clifford William Fournier, Kyrgyzstan national Aidana Baizieva, Jamaluddin's personal bodyguard Razakan Seran and businessman Datuk Tan Huat Seang.
