

Puteri Umno lodges police report over Sarawak Report's 1MDB article

Puteri Umno today lodged a police report against the Sarawak Report news portal over an article, which it claimed, was aimed at defaming and discrediting the reputation of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

Its chief, Datuk Mas Ermieyati Samsudin, said the article on the controversial 1Malaysia Development Bhd (1MDB) funds seemed intended to influence the people.

"The article is clearly an attempt to defame and discredit the reputation of Datuk Seri Najib and his leadership, which we believe is malicious and foul.

"Puteri calls for a thorough investigation against those who published the defamatory article," she told reporters after lodging the report at the Masjid Tanah police station in Malacca.

Mas Ermieyati said the article quoted sources, which did not show sound proof, and this had a negative effect on Malaysians and people elsewhere.

As such, she called on all quarters to take immediate action to stop defaming the prime minister and creating confusion among the people.

Earlier, Umno Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin said he supported any move to

take legal action against WSJ which had run a similar article on 1MDB, claiming that about RM2.6 billion had been channelled into the personal bank accounts of Najib.

Najib's political secretary Datuk Muhammad Khairun Aseh told the Sinar Harian yesterday that the article was tantamount to criminal defamation and that the prime minister would take legal action against WSJ.

The Prime Minister's Office had said in a statement yesterday that the allegations were a continuation of political sabotage and that certain individuals were trying to tarnish the government and remove a democratically-elected prime minister. – Bernama, July 4, 2015.
