

**PM's Political Secretary Visits Saidin Thamby**

KUALA LUMPUR, July 14 (Bernama) -- Former Paya Jaras state assemblyman Datuk Saidin Thamby today received a visit from the political secretary to the prime minister, Datuk Ghazali Ibrahim, at his home in Selayang.

Saidin, 79, who is bedridden due to stroke since the beginning of this year, was touched by the visit of Ghazali, who represented Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"Thank you for coming. I'm not well, old and can't move. Thanks for still remembering me. I love Najib," he said.

Saidin, who was Selangor state assembly speaker, is getting regular treatment at Selayang Hospital and the National Stroke Society Malaysia (NASAM).

Ghazali told reporters that Najib expressed sympathy over the health problems faced by Saidin.

He also prays for Saidin's good health so that he can celebrate Aidilfitri.

"The prime minister got news that a friend is unwell and planned to visit. Since he is busy, I was asked to represent him.

"I am very sad and proud when he said he loves Datuk Seri Najib. He (Saidin) still follows political developments although unwell," he said.

During the visit, Ghazali presented a donation to Saidin on behalf of the prime minister.
