

70,000 People Expected At Aidilfitri Open House Hosted By PM And Cabinet Ministers At Seri Perdana

PUTRAJAYA, July 15 (Bernama) -- Around 70,000 visitors are expected to attend the Hari Raya Open House with the Prime Minister and Cabinet Ministers at the Seri Perdana complex on the first day of Aidilfitri.

Private Secretary to the Prime Minister Mohd Shahrir Mohd Aripin said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his wife Datin Seri Rosmah invite all Malaysians to attend the open house.

"Delicacies consisting of traditional Malay, Indian and Chinese cuisine, will be served to the visitors," he told reporters after inspecting the preparations for the open house at the complex here, Wednesday.

The open house will be held from 10.30 am to 4 pm.

Checks by Bernama found workers busy making the final preparations, installing tents and arranging flower decorations around the complex.

Mohd Shahrir said if the first day of Hari Raya fell on a Friday, the prime minister and Muslim cabinet ministers as well as Muslim guests would leave at 12.30pm to perform the Friday prayers while the non-Muslim ministers would continue entertaining the non-Muslim guests.

He said a free bus service will be provided by Bas Putrajaya in three locations, namely Putrajaya Sentral, Masjid Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin and Masjid Putra running on a 15-minute interval.

The Prime Minister's Department in a statement yesterday advised the public to dress appropriately for the occasion, and use the same bus stop for their to and fro shuttle.
