

Malaysia Open New Consulate General Office In Nanning, China

KUALA LUMPUR, July 16 (Bernama) -- Malaysia has established a new Consulate General Office in Nanning, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region in China.

According to a statement from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bong Yik Jui, has been appointed as the first Consul General to Nanning covering the consular districts of Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region and Guizhou Province.
